## Content agreed on for OBEC training courses

As part of the project, the OBEC project partners will be running short courses between November 2021 and April 2022. Certificates will be issued for them using - you guessed it - a blockchain database, something which will allow the participants to reliably prove their completion of the courses later. In this way, they will serve as a handy way to test run a blockchain-based certification system for education and skills, the main purpose of OBEC.

The courses will cover various topics depending on the individual partners' expertise. All will, however, include modules on starting a business, creating a business idea and plan, and using blockchain technology to verify credentials. EURADA's course will otherwise focus on entrepreneurship in the Circular Economy.

Stay tuned to hear more about the course later in the year. In the meantime we are getting to work on developing it and setting up our blockchain database.
