Training courses have started

In Sweden, 30 participants in total joined the OBEC trainings that included four different sessions with a total of 25h of duration. The topics included the circular economy, soft skills for responsible entrepreneurship, how to start a business in Sweden and how to build a business plan. Given the demand, following the first trainings, a second slot of trainings have been scheduled, which has recently been finalised

EURADA hosted two online training courses. The first training course "Create Your Business Idea and Plan" took place between 8 and 10 March. The second course "Working in a Circular Economy Context" took place between 15 and 17 March. During both trainings, an average of 25 participants heard from actors in the field for a total of 24 hours.

In Croatia, SIMORA organised the testing phase trainings for 35 participants focusing on programming, graphics basics in gaming development, and advanced techniques in the Unity tool and Blender software.

Lai-Momo organised a practical tailoring course lasting 30 hours which started on February 21st and ended on March 4th where participants portrayed great satisfaction with learning new manual skills and the birth of many new friendships.

UniUrb has completed two modules. The first module "Critical Thinking" had 20 participants and lasted for 36 hours. The second model "Ethics of Artificial Intelligence" attracted 8 students for a total of 12 hours. UniUrb is currently running a training course on logical fallacies for roughly 18 students for a total of 36 hours. Furthermore, a coding course is currently being developed.
